

Pansies with Pizzazz

Colossus / Majestic Giant series

This is a free flowering pansy with blooms up to 4" across. These vigorous early-blooming plants grow up to 6" in height and have attractive faces. A favorite fall selection.

The Crown series

These pansies have large blooms measuring up to 3" across. The flower colors are clear and without blotches. These are a great choice for mass plantings.

The Delta series

These are low growing spreading pansies with upright 3" flowers on extremely sturdy stems. The colors are solid and blotches. An eye-catcher!

Violas

This series has many charming hybrids, including Johnny Jump-ups. Numerous small blooms are perfect for large or small plantings.

Pansies vs. Violas

Pansy blooms are much larger than violas, but the violas have many more blooms. Violas generally work better in containers as the blooms are smaller and not so overpowering.

Planting pansies:

Mix Mushroom compost and Premium Pansy Food into soil according to instructions on packages.

After planting, use Ferti-lome Root Stimulator at a rate of 3 1/2 tbsp per gallon once a week for three weeks.

Pansies and violas are heavy feeders, so feed with Pansy Food once a month. Water pansies and violas regularly.
